Best Practices

Forklift Battery Maintenance Tips

Check electrolyte levels periodically

It's important to look at your battery's electrolyte levels at the intervals specified in your owner's manual and to replace water lost due to evaporation. Never allow electrolyte levels to drop below the separator protectors, and do not overfill the cells. Overfilling causes loss of acid, reduces battery capacity, and results in corrosion of the steel tray. Here are some watering tips for your forklift batteries:

- Batteries should only be topped off after a full charge; never top it off before a charge
- Fill to 1/8" below the bottom of the vent well to avoid overfilling
- Only use distilled water when filling your batteries
